Assignment #1:

Career Search: Get familiar with the following website: www.bls.gov/ooh and do a career search. Look up a job that is interesting to you and research there pay, duties, work environment, and how to pursue that career. Write a brief summary of your findings at the end and title it "Career Search."

Assignment #2:

College Search: Get familiar with the following websites:

In the college data website do a college match to see which one suits your goals and needs. You can also see what your chances are of getting into your desired college. You can also calculate your family contribution by using the EFC calculator.

In the white house website locate a college of interest. If you do not plan on pursuing a college education, do a search on local San Diego schools like San Diego State University or Southwestern College to find out the programs they offer and cost of going to that college.

Finally, write a brief summary of your findings and title it "College Search."
