Assignment #1:

Now that you have had the opportunity to think if college is for you, I am sure you have thought about what career you plan on pursuing when you graduate from high school. Write a 5 paragraph essay (typed) on your ideal career. Keep it to 3-5 pages minimum. Refer back to the websites from week #6 to get ideas on how much training if any you will have to do (college, no college, training program). Discuss the salary that you expect to make. Finally, what interest you to pursue this career. This assignment will be due on Week #9: Tuesday, November 1st. It must be typed, 12 inch font, check your grammar, and either submit it by hand or email it to me: joe.medina@learningchoice.org . If you refer back to the websites from week #6, you do not need to include a reference page. Include a reference page if you find information in other websites or books. This assignment is worth two weeks worth of homework so please take it seriously and submit it on time.

Here is a simple format for how to keep your essay organized:

Paragraph 1: Introduction, introduce yourself and briefly discuss the career goal that you will be discussing.

Paragraph 2: Discuss training that you will have to do to pursue this career. Refer back to what you researched on the websites from week #6.

Paragraph 3: Salary expectation. How much do you expect to make when you begin this career. What the maximum that you will make it this career if you decide to retire from it. What are some of the benefits to this career (medical, dental, retirement, vacation, etc).

Paragraph 4: What interest you to pursue this career? Sibling, hobby, money. Why are you willing to pursue to go through the training if its intensive? Really think about this. Do you want to help others? In other words, what would you bring to this profession?

Paragraph 5: Conclude your paragraph. Quickly review what you wrote about. I recommend you end it with a quote that inspires you. If you do, then let me know where your heard this quote or who said it.
